Friday, May 20, 7 p.m.

Matthew West: Matthew West is one of the top Christian singer/songwriters in the business. His most recent album, "The Story of Your Life," is a groundbreaking collection of songs he penned based on the real life experiences of his fans. His previous album, "Something to Say," produced the number-one hit "You Are Everything," which was the most played Christian song of 2008. The album also includes the Grammy Award-nominated song "The Motions" – number one on the Billboard Christian chart for 14 weeks, as well as the most played song on Christian radio in 2009. This will be West's second time as part of a Will Graham Celebration, having performed all three nights of last year's Celebration in Auburn, Ala.

God Rocks!: God Rocks!, a Canadian group that reaches out specifically to children, was created to "energize kids with the Good News" and to teach them important lessons from the Bible in a fun way. According to their website, "The *God Rocks!* universe is based on Luke 19:40: 'If the people fall silent, the stones will cry out.' Fun rock characters live in the imaginary town of Rocky Ridge, where they live to sing and praise God – just in case the people fall silent!"

Newsboys: Two of the biggest Christian bands of the last 25 years are the Grammy Award-nominated Newsboys, and the Grammy Award-winning dc Talk. Now, with dc Talk alum Michael Tait onboard as lead singer for the Newsboys, they have combined the two dynasties into one Christian super-group. The Newsboys released their most recent album, "Born Again," – the first collaboration with Tait – in the summer of 2010. In April 2011 they re-released the album, with several added songs, under the name "Born Again: Miracles Edition." Tait is no stranger to Will Graham Celebrations, having previously shared the stage with Graham in Kentucky and Ohio.

Flame: FLAME is a Christian Hip-Hop recording artist with Clear Sight Music. He has released several albums including: self-titled "FLAME," "Rewind," "Our World Fallen," and the Grammy Award-nominated "Our World Redeemed." FLAME has also been nominated for Dove and Stellar awards throughout his music career. His newest album, "Captured," was released on Dec. 28, 2010, and debuted at #1 on the Billboard Gospel chart and #5 on the Billboard Christian chart.

Chasen: Up-and-coming Christian rock band Chasen was named one of CCM Magazine's "Most Likely to Succeed" for 2010. Fronted by worship leader Chasen Callahan of Greenville, S.C., Chasen has already racked up two number ones on Christian radio, including "Castaway" (five weeks at number one) and "On and On" (six weeks at number one). In addition, they've had a pair of top five hits in "Crazy Beautiful" and "Drown."
